- Workers wanted fair wages and better working conditions.

What was the result?

- The revolutionaries won important victories against Díaz's army.
- Díaz agreed to step down and called for new elections.

Mexican Revolution

How did it happen?

- Madero, who had tried to run for president and was exiled, called for an armed revolution.
- Leaders arose in different parts of Mexico and gathered their own armies.
- They beat Díaz's army.
