World War One

- more death and destruction than ever seen before
- millions dead and wounded; drained European treasuries
- destroyed farmland, homes, villages, towns

World War One

- people felt disillusioned, insecure, and despairing
- League of Nations created to promote peace

World War One

- peace treaties punished Germany, created new nations, left legacy of bitterness and resentment
- U.S. emerged as dominant nation in world

World War Two

- more death and destruction than any other conflict in history
- millions dead
- millions homeless
- property damage in billions of dollars

World War Two

- hundreds of cities reduced to rubble
- much of countryside destroyed
- people without water and electricity and with little food
- displaced persons wandered countryside

World War Two

- thousands died of famine and disease
- people without shoes and coats in winter
- some prewar governments returned
- communists made gains at first in Italy and France but then declined as economies recovered

World War Two

- thousands died of famine and disease
- Nazi war criminals tried
- U.S. and Soviet Union emerged as two major world powers
