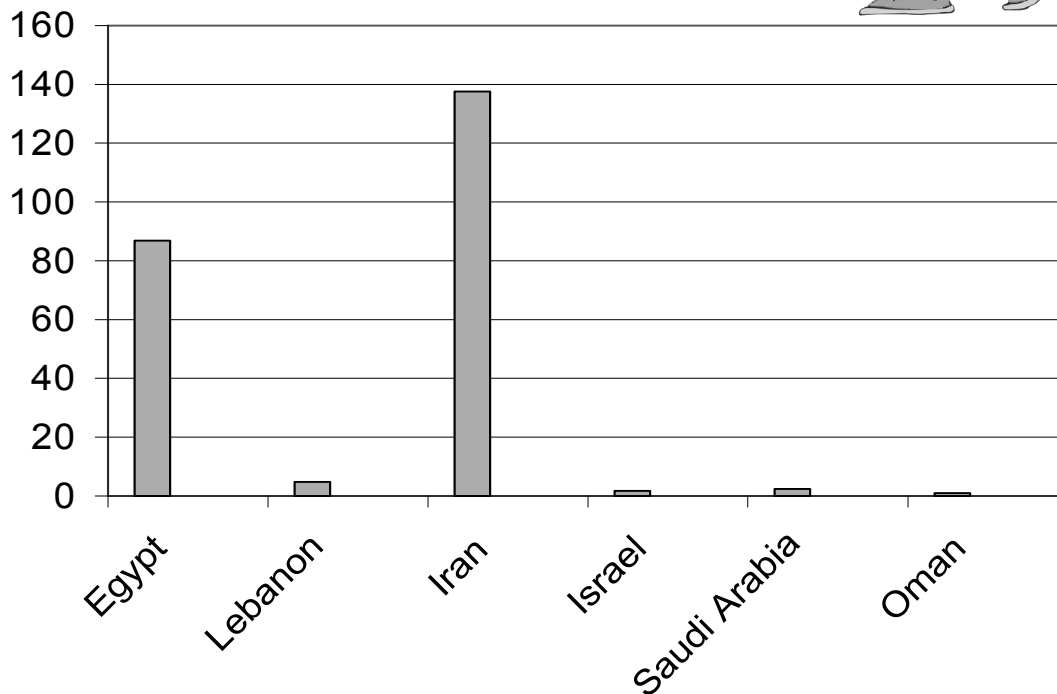
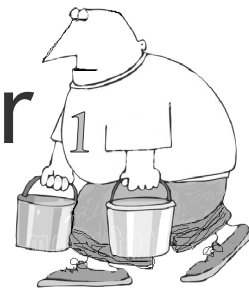


Available Water
