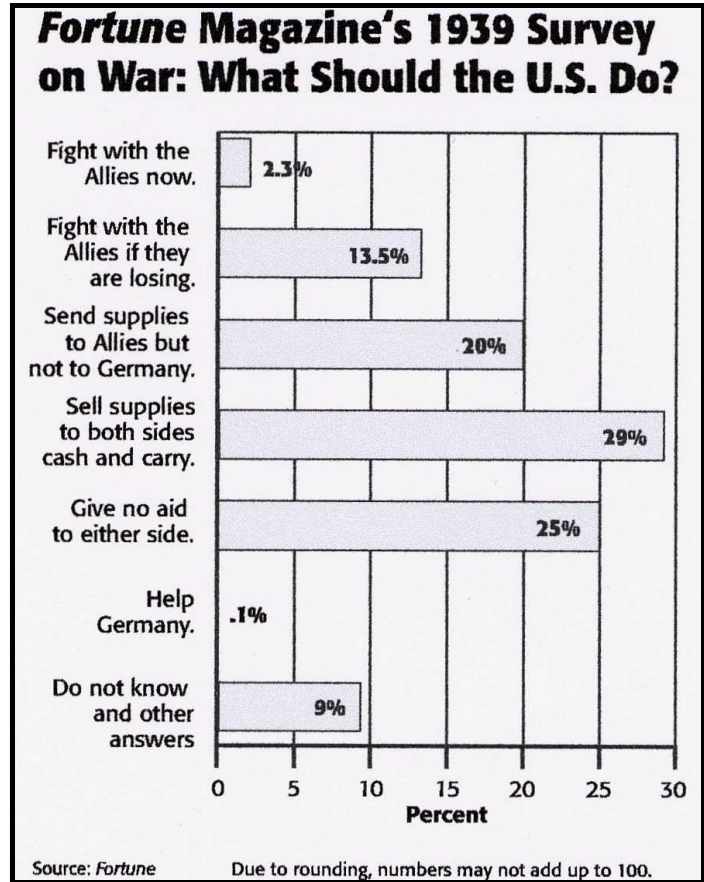


What Should the U.S. Do?
