Main Ideas

- 1. A totalitarian state has a government that has complete control over its citizens and puts down all opposition.
- 2. Possible response: It did not prevent war. It just gave the Nazis more territory without fighting.
- 3. Jews, Gypsies, Jehovah's Witnesses, homosexuals, the mentally and physically handicapped
- Possible response: The United States used the cash-andcarry and Lend-Lease programs to help the countries that fought against Germany.

Thinking Critically

- Possible response: Hitler, Stalin, and Tojo tried to expand their countries by invading their neighbors and taking their territory away. Eventually, other countries decided that they had to use force to stop them. The fighting that broke out was World War II.
- Possible response: The Axis powers, especially Germany, did bad things. The Nazis attempted to commit genocide against the Jews. It was important that these people be stopped from committing more atrocities against other people.
