Main Ideas

- The first stop was the Battle of Britain, in which German air forces battled for months without breaking Britain's defenses.
- 2. Japan bombed Pearl Harbor and took over Guam, Wake, the Philippines, Indonesia, Hong Kong, Malaya, and Singapore.
- 3. Hitler targeted the Roma, Poles, Russians, the mentally and physically disabled, and, especially, the Jews.
- 4. Possible response: British and Soviet citizens died. People faced rationing. Japanese Americans were imprisoned.
- The occupation led to Japan's demilitarization and major changes in government.

Thinking Critically

- Possible response: The U.S. took sides with the Allies by selling them weapons and then escorting the ships that took weapons to Great Britain. The U.S. also took sides by working with Great Britain to issue the Atlantic Charter. It also gave military aid to China (against Japan) and cut off oil shipments to Japan.
- 2. Possible response: Although the U.S. won the Battle of the Coral Sea, its losses were heavy. Although the U.S. won the Battle of Guadalcanal, it took six months to do so.
