- The Allies forced the Germans out of Africa. The Red Army forced the Germans to surrender at Stalingrad. The Americans and British forced the Italians to surrender.
- 2. Japanese Americans who lived on the West Coast were placed in relocation camps.
- 3. Possible response: D-Day, the Battle of the Bulge, the surrounding of Berlin, and the suicide of Hitler.
- 4. Possible response: the Battle of Leyte Gulf, the defeat at Iwo Jima, the defeat at Okinawa, the bombing of Hiroshima, and the bombing of Nagasaki.
