1. The Allies forced the Germans out of Africa. The Red Army forced the Germans to surrender at Stalingrad. The Americans and British forced the Italians to surrender.
2. Japanese Americans who lived on the West Coast were placed in relocation camps.
3. Possible response: D-Day, the Battle of the Bulge, the surrounding of Berlin, and the suicide of Hitler.
4. Possible response: the Battle of Leyte Gulf, the defeat at Iwo Jima, the defeat at Okinawa, the bombing of Hiroshima, and the bombing of Nagasaki.
