Why did the war begin?

- Hitler had already taken over Rhineland, Austria, and Czechoslovakia before invading Poland.
- France and Britain had hoped to appease Hitler, but with his invasion of Poland, it became obvious that Hitler had to be stopped.

How was the first attack conducted?

- Hitler used the strategy of blitzkrieg, or “lightning war.”
- Fast-moving airplanes and tanks, followed by massive infantry forces, conducted surprise attacks and quickly overwhelmed the enemy.
